"This morning we had a gearbox pump oil leak on Ralph's car and had to change the engine because some wiring was damaged. He was in the t-car for the rest of the session and had a fuel pressure problem at the end which turned out to be an internal tank problem. Giancarlo had no real dramas and we got through our tyre evaluation work. As far as qualifying goes, it's the same as normal. We have to be quicker and there's a lot to do."
