JORDAN FORD TESTING REPORT

BARCELONA, SPAIN Monday 17th February 2003

DriverGiancarlo FisichellaRalph FirmanChassisEJ13 / 02EJ13 / 03

Jordan Ford continued its testing programme with Giancarlo Fisichella and Ralph Firman running two EJ13s simultaneously for the first time, in clear and cool conditions at the Circuit de Catalunya.

Both drivers worked on general aerodynamic and mechanical chassis balance work and Fisichella completed 32 laps, setting the third quickest lap time of 1:19.13. Meanwhile Firman concentrated on adding 69 laps to his F1 mileage, with a fastest lap time of 1:19.46. The day was productive other than minor interruptions including a small engine problem for Fisichella and a gearbox glitch for Firman.

Gary Anderson, Director of Race and Test Engineering said, "It was a normal testing day, we added quite a few miles to the EJ13 and are beginning to understand more about the car and how to make it work best on the tyres."
